Kaspersky Antivirus Review

Is Kaspersky Antivirus a Scam? Is Kaspersky Antivirus Safe to Install? Any Complaints?

No complaints have been filed on consumer complaint sites for this software. Kaspersky Antivirus is safe to install according to consumer feedback.

Pros:

-Kaspersky Antivirus is certified by West Coast Labs ([see here](#)) and Virus Bulletin ([see here](#)), which are both highly-respected 3rd party testers of malware software. Moreover, this software has earned the "Advanced" award from AV Comparatives, another authority in the antivirus software testing field, for its malware detection rate of 94.7% (see the pdf test report [here](#)).

-This software is updated frequently, at the average rate of over 17 updates/day since the start of 2009, according to AV-Test[dot]org ([see here](#)).

-Consumer feedback for this product has been very positive for the most part, except for some people complaining about it being a resource hog (see "Cons" section for details).

-A 30-day trial of this software is available for download at the merchant site.

Cons:

-The only complaint is that this software can be a resource hog for machines that don't have a lot of RAM. If you experience this problem, we would recommend that you increase your RAM or schedule Kaspersky to run while you're not using the computer.
